# Programme of Commemoration Events

28 men of Clarborough & Welham Parish were killed in action or died of wounds received in World War 1. The Parish Council, St John the Baptist Church and the WI have come together to present the programme of commemorative events below.

A display of poppies along Main Street Welham and Main Street Clarborough is already installed as is a 'Silent Silhouette Tommy' at the Clarborough and Welham boundary.

**Flower Festival** - St John the Baptist Church, Church Lane, Clarborough  
Flower arrangement display plus Poppy Cascade by W.I.

**Sunday 11 November - 10.45 am to 11.30 am (approx.)**

**Remembrance Day Service** - St John the Baptist Church, Church Lane, Clarborough.

**Sunday 11 November - 1.30 pm to 1.45 pm**

**Planting of Memorial Copse** - Parish Pasture, Broad Gores, Clarborough. 5 Commemorative Oak Trees will be planted by residents of the Parish.

**Sunday 11 November - 1.50 pm to 3.30 pm**

**Drop-in display** commemorating the 28 men of the Parish who died in World War 1. Clarborough Village Hall, Main Street, Clarborough.

**Free hot refreshments** will be provided by the W.I.

**Sunday 11 November - 6.30 pm**

**Free Mini-bus transport** - Village Hall car park to the Parish Beacon.

**Reading of the National Dedication** at the Beacon lighting.

**Sounding of the Last Post** at the Beacon lighting.

**Sunday 11 November - 7.00 pm**

**Lighting of the Parish Beacon** - Top of Howbeck Lane, Clarborough

[One of 1,200 Beacons to be lit across the country]

**Sunday 11 November - 7.05 pm**

**Ringling of the Church bells** - St John the Baptist Church [national event].
